25 Twenty-Second Street East, upstairs in the YMCA Building & SSD Saskatoon School of Dance, 407 Cumberland Ave South.

Dance Sessions are 9 months long. Sessions begin in September and end with the Flamenco Expo (recital) the following early June. Late enrollment will be prorated. There is a **onetime registration fee** of \$20 per student, however if registering on or before registration day this fee will be waived.

PERFORMANCES

- Performances allow students to gain confidence, provide a service to the community and utilize the recital costumes.
- Costume fees are due at the time the order is placed. Costume fees are not refundable. Costumes usually cost between \$60 and \$120 each.
- As a courtesy, recital fees are not charged however will be assessed depending on venue.
- Periodic community performances may be available at the instructors’ discretion.

ATTENDANCE

- Regular attendance provides the opportunity for students to advance at similar rates, prepare for performances and work as a cohesive team. Absences will affect a student’s performance. Excessive absences may prevent participation in performances. Absences do not affect tuition.
- 24-hour notice of cancellation must be given to the school or the lesson is forfeited. (Bonafide emergencies excepted)

- Make-up lessons are subject to classroom availability and instructor discretion. Make-up classes must be taken within 4 weeks of a missed class or it will be forfeited.
- Warm up time is important in any sport to avoid injury. For the safety of each student, any student arriving after the warm-up (after the first 10 minutes of class) will be responsible for their own warm up.

ATTIRE

Proper attire must be worn at all times! This includes Flamenco shoes (approved by instructor), comfortable cotton shirt or body suit, yoga pants or something similar and a full practice skirt (original flamenco skirt or a similar design from home).

Proper clothing allows:

1. Assessment of proper form
2. Freedom of movement
3. Proper respiration
4. Prevention of injury

TUITION AND FEE SCHEDULE

Tuition is charged by session, is per student and adjusted according to the number of classes for which a student is registered.

Full tuition is due at the time of registration. As a courtesy, tuition may be made in 9 monthly installments date the 1st of each month. All 9 installments are due at the time of registration. Monthly installments do not vary regardless of holiday closure or months in which 5 lessons are offered. Tuition reserves a student's place in a class whether or not they attend. Therefore, tuition does not vary according to attendance.

One Time Registration Fee:

\$20 per student (\$15 per subsequent family member), however if registering on or before registration day, this fee will be waived. Non-refundable if registration is received after the deadline.

Trial Class Fee:

- *Free* for the first class
- Second class is \$20 (60 minutes), \$25 (90 minutes), \$30 (2 hours) or \$50 per private class

Monthly payments are due 10 days before the first of the month (September classes are due on registration day) All cheques dated the 1st of the month. A Late fee of \$15.00 will be assessed on the 7th. Class participation may be denied for outstanding accounts.

Monthly Installments are all due on or before registration deadline date, with each of the 9 cheques dated the 1st of each month. A Late fee of \$15.00 will be assessed on the 7th. Class participation may be denied for outstanding accounts.

Extra Discount Price if paid in 1, 2 or 3 cheques received on or before registration deadline

- Take 25% off the Regular class price if payment for 9 months is received in One cheque (dated Sept 1)
- Take 22% off the Regular class price if payment for 9 months is received in Two cheques (dated Sept 1st and Jan 1st)
- Take 20% off the Regular class price if payment for 9 months is received in Three cheque (dated Sept 1, Jan 1, Mar 1)

Monthly Installments are due on or before registration deadline date, with each of the cheques dated the 1st of each month. A Late fee of \$15.00 will be assessed on the 7th. Class participation may be denied for outstanding accounts.

Registration process

You can register by mail or in-person:

- Complete the "Registration form" and mail post-dated cheques to Kari Alba (1212 Ave J South, Saskatoon, S7M 2C4). All cheques should be addressed to "Alma Flamenca".
- In-Person registration is Aug 31, 2011 6:30-9pm at the YMCA. Only cash or cheque will be accepted.
- There is a onetime registration fee of \$20 per student, however if registering on or before registration day this fee will be waived.

REFUNDS AND OTHERS

- There are no refunds for classes paid by monthly installment. If tuition is paid in full and a student must drop a class, a prorated portion of the tuition will be refundable. An administrative fee of \$30 will be assessed for dropped classes before refund is received.
- 30 day written notice (a receipt will be provided) must be given for any dropped class, whether paid on the installment plan or paid in full.
- Private lessons for catching-up are available for a fee of \$40 or \$50 per class and subject to instructor approval.
- Students may join a class in mid-session, but may not be prepared to participate in the recital.
- Placement is according to instructor approval.
